Note: Medicaid and Child Health Plus are based on current Federal Poverty Levels (FPL). Premium tax credits and Cost-Sharing Reductions will be based on 2015 Federal Poverty Levels for the 2016 enrollment period. Medicaid eligibility is different for different age groups: Ages 19-64=138% FPL; 1-18=154%FPL; <1 and pregnant women=223% FPL.

*Aliessa Immigrants: Aliessa immigrants are lawfully present "immigrant non-citizens" or "PRUCOL". But note that PRUCOL-only (aka Residual PRUCOL) will remain in state-funded Medicaid.
